Royal Cord Requirements

Due by May 3, 2024

Students will have the responsibility to apply for the Royal cord and complete the application. **This is not the job of your advisor**, please complete all required information and documentation. The application process will be in the form of a dossier showing verification of the following criteria. Late and/or incomplete applications will result in application denial.

- Academics- 3.2 or better cum GPA
- Attendance- No attendance credit loss (all 3 years of high school). If there are special extenuating circumstances this will be evaluated on an individual basis by the committee.
- Citizenship- No U permitted. No more than three N's. (over the course of all 3 years of high school)
- Student Involvement/Leadership Seniors need to be active participating members in a club or organization for their entire high school years, and/or earn an award at the state or national level competition. It does not need to be the same club. Multiple clubs are okay as long as the requirements are met.
- Service- 25 hours or more of service. A maximum of 15 and a minimum of 10 hours may be earned during the senior year. Other service/volunteer hours need to be earned during their sophomore and junior years, as hours should be spread over the three years of your high school time. Service hours must be preapproved or club affiliated. Hours that are not pre-approved or lack a confirmation and signature from a club advisor will not be accepted.

Students with less than 2 years of attendance at Roy High or that have extenuating circumstances may apply and shall be evaluated on an individual basis. Roy High School must be the main attendance school where the majority of academic hours have been completed.

Each student that applies will receive a letter of acceptance or denial. In case of denial, the student will be informed of the reason or reasons. An appeal process will be available. Late or incomplete applications will not be eligible for appeal.
